



## Part Number 57-0346 INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

## NISSAN PRIMERA 2.0L 16v 10/1996 - 9/1999

- Remove the intake hose & harness plug from the MAS (Mass Air Sensor).
  (Fig. 1)
- 2. Remove the air box lid assembly from the air box base. (Fig. 2)
- 3. Remove the 3 bolts from inside the air box base & carefully lift out the base from the vehicle. (Fig. 3)
- **4.** Carefully remove the MAS from the air box lid. (Fig. 4)
- **5.** Fit the metal filter adaptor to the front of the MAS using the M6 bolts supplied (loosely fit M6 x 25 mm bolt to the R/H lower hole). (Fig. 5)
- **6.** Fit the mounting bracket to the chassis leg using the original air box mounting point & mounting bolt. (Fig. 6)
- 7. Fit the MAS assembly to the intake hose, attach the MAS to the mounting bracket using the M6 x 25 mm bolt. Reconnect the harness plug. (Fig. 7)
- 8. Carefully expand the flexi cold air hose & feed the hose down to the undertray. Use a plastic tie to ensure that the hose clears the clutch lever. Secure the top of the hose to finish approx. 10 cm / 4" from the Air Filter using a plastic tie. (Fig. 8)
- **9.** Drill two 4mm holes in the undertray and secure the end of the flexi cold air hose to it using a plastic tie. (Fig. 9)
- **10.** Fit the new Air Filter to the metal filter adaptor, ensure that the K&N logo is straight then fully tighten the #104 clip. (Fig.10)

WARNING: Before starting the engine carry out a final fitment check of the K&N performance kit. It will be necessary for a lintake systems to be checked periodically for realignment, clearance and tightening of all connections. Failure to follow the above instructions or proper maintenance may void the warranty.

FILTER MAINTENANCE: K&N suggests checking the filter periodically for excessive dirt build-up. When the element becomes covered in dirt (or once a year), service it according to the instructions on the Recharger service kit available from your K&N dealer, part number 99-5003EU.
