This filter fits directly into your OE Air Box Assembly, with an OE style sealing bead. No cutting or fitting is required. K&N's NEW "RACE-SPEC" High-Flow Air Filter is performance designed to provide a significant boost in airflow, resulting in increased horsepower & torque. Built with 2 Layers of special pleated media and designed to open up the pleats and provide very low restriction. This K&N® High-Flow Air Filter is washable & reusable, Some filters may require applying oil prior to installation for the first time. There are special installation instructions, so please follow the procedures outlined below to ensure the K&N® Air Filter seals properly.

INSTALLATION:

1. Remove the stock air filter from the air box.
2. Remove the two screws from the stock air filter by pushing them out from the backside. (Fig. 1)
3. Install the two screws (removed in the above step) into the supplied frame as shown, using the two supplied retainers. (Fig. 2 & 3)
4. Install the K&N® filter into the air box with the seal on the filter sitting in the channel of the air box. (Fig. 4)
5. Install the frame into the air box with the tabs on the frame sliding in underneath the three retaining clips. (Fig. 5)
6. Push the frame down to allow you to align the screws with the holes in the air box. Tighten the screws down evenly to pull the frame into place. (Fig. 6)
7. Re-install the air box lid.

THESE INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED EVERY TIME THE FILTER IS SERVICED, OTHERWISE THE FILTER MAY NOT SEAL, AND DAMAGE TO THE ENGINE COULD RESULT.
